Cost is \$600 per person (last season's prices, so check current) and includes:  
An experienced guide, safety equipment and beacon, hands-on instruction on how to use equipment and how to safely navigate terrain.

Get in a 12-person heated PistenBully Snowcat with a guide who will show you all the best drop-in zones in Schweitzer's private backcountry. The resort owns 4,350 acres untouched powder skiing bliss in the west bowl of Schweitzer Basin, beyond the resort's western boundaries. Add yourself to a group or bring some friends. Ride on this intermediate-to-advanced terrain zone that only a couple dozen skiers and riders get access to each day. With 300 inches of annual snowfall, your lines won't be skied-out.

**Q: How many runs/how much vertical?**

It entirely depends on the snow, weather and group level. They average around 8 runs and 11,000 vertical feet a day.

**Q: What Ability Level is Required to Go Cat-Skiing?**

For our backcountry adventures, you must be a competent Black Diamond skier or snowboarder and be comfortable with a minimum of Blue Square level powder riding.
